RE-BID - Tomahawk Creek Parkway North Pond & Trail Rehabilitation
NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids shall be received by the City of Leawood, Kansas, at the office of the City Clerk until 10:30 am, Central Legal Time on Tuesday, March 20, 2012, for the construction, complete, of the Tomahawk Creek Parkway North Pond & Trail Rehabilitation, said work to include: Traffic control and trail closure control, Pond draining, overexcavation and haul off, Pond rock excavation and haul off, existing asphalt trail removals, Clearing and Grubbing, Storm sewer removals and replacements, Pond liner construction with alternates, asphalt trail realignment construction, excavation, fill and compaction, minor grading and shaping, erosion control, seeding, and other construction.

All bids shall be submitted in sealed envelopes addressed to the City Clerk, City of Leawood, 4800 Town Center Drive, Leawood, Kansas 66211, and shall be clearly marked "TOMAHAWK CREEK PARKWAY NORTH POND & TRAIL REHABILITATION" (IN CAPITAL LETTERS). At the above stated time and place, all bids shall be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after the designated closing time will be returned unopened.

Contractors desiring Contract Documents for use in preparing bids may obtain a set of such documents from Drexel Technologies at 10840 W 86th Street, Lenexa, Kansas 66214. Cost of documents shall be set by Drexel 913-371-4430. There shall be no refunds.

A mandatory attendance pre-bid meeting will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 13, 2012 at Leawood City Hall located at 4800 Town Center Road, Leawood, Kansas 66211. Attendance of the pre-bid meeting is prerequisite to acceptance of bid. The meeting will be held in the first floor main conference room.

Contractors who had attended the original mandatory pre-bid meeting held on Thursday, February 9, 2012 are not required to attend the pre-bid meeting on March 13, 2012 in order to submit a bid.

Each bidder shall file with their bid proposal a cashier's check, certified check, or bid proposal bond, drawn on an acceptable bank in an amount of five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid.

Nonresident corporations that are not already registered with the Kansas Secretary of State, and all nonresident individuals and partnerships are required by law to register with the Director of Revenue, State Office Building, Topeka, Kansas, and to pay a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each and every contract, as a precedent to commencing work on the contract. For contracts in excess of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) the foreign contractor shall file with the Director of Revenue an acceptable bond in amount of ten percent (10%) of the contract.

No bid may be withdrawn within a period of thirty (30) calendar days from and after the date fixed for opening bids.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and to waive any informalities or irregularities therein.
