TAKE UP THE GAUNTLET

- Negotiate curbside recycling for all residents with your waste management provider.
- Notify all members that your HOA will accept the challenge.
- Use any/all communications to inform and educate your residents.
- Announce the Green Gauntlet at your meetings.
- Distribute the complimentary “What goes in my bin?” magnet to every member of your HOA.
