## CPR, AED & First Aid Training

Bystander Response in an emergency can literally make the difference between life and death. One of our goals is to educate as many people in our community as possible in what to do in a medical or trauma emergency.

LFD has certified instructors on each shift that can come to your location to teach hands-only CPR in only around 20 minutes. Longer, more in-depth classes that incorporate infants and children, choking, First Aid, etc., are also available at the department and result in you earning a two-year certification card.
