

**Minutes of the Stormwater Management Committee

Topic of Discussion: MINUTES OF PAST MEETING

Action: (Once a quorum of members was present), Member Bill Chiles made a Motion to approve the Minutes from the last Committee Meeting held January 27, 2010. Member Pat Dunn seconded the Motion. All members were in favor. Motion passed unanimously.

Topic of Discussion: UPDATE THE COMMITTEE ON STORMWATER WEB PAGE

Action: No action required. This was information only.

Joe Johnson displayed the new web page information that the Public Works Department has been working on for the City's web site. This site will describe and educate the public on stormwater issues. The site has many links and directs the user to various locations dealing with flooding, swimming pool draining, pet waste, recycling, residential and community stormwater runoff, watershed definition and water pollution to name a few items. After today's meeting, the site will be up and running on the City's web site and available for public viewing.

Mr. Johnson advised that one of the capabilities the web site allows the user, is the ability to type in an address (anywhere in the United States) on the U.S. FEMA map and see where that address falls in the flood zone. There is also a form on the website where one can report illegal discharge activities or concerns to the Public Works Department.

Chair Rawlings advised he did not know of any pressing issues and due to Spring Break, did not plan on having a meeting in March. Staff will inform Committee Members via e-mail and the other members absent today of there not being a March schedule. **The next regular meeting is scheduled for the last Wednesday in April-and is planned to be April 28, 2010.**
