## City to Install 19<sup>th</sup> Piece of Public Art

The Arts in Public Places Initiative (APPI) recently selected a new piece of public art scheduled for installation in the spring. The piece was accepted by the Leawood Arts Council who received approval from the City Council to purchase it. Ewerdt Hilgeman, an internationally recognized artist, created the piece, entitled "Dancers", which consists of two 20 foot high columns – one of stainless steel and one of corten steel. It was recently on display in front of the Kansas City Art Institute as part of the International Sculpture Conference.

The installation site will be just north of Leawood City Hall on the west side of Roe. This will be the 19th piece of public art in the city's collection.
