



CITY OF LEAWOOD AMENDMENT POLICY

The City Prosecutor’s Office has implemented a policy to streamline in-person requests for traffic ticket amendments¹ or reduced fines² in certain instances. Previously, all persons requesting traffic amendments or reduced fines were required to meet with the City Prosecutor. Now, those who meet all of the requirements below may appear at the municipal court clerk window to request an amendment or reduced fine. **No amendments will be processed by mail.**

The following is a list of traffic violations that are eligible for amendment or reduced fine, and the requirements. **The defendant must personally appear (or his/her attorney) at the municipal court to request an amendment or reduced fine.** No mail-in amendments will be accepted.

AMENDMENTS AND REDUCED FINES ARE A PRIVILEGE AND NOT A RIGHT.
Nothing herein shall be construed as an agreement or promise to amend or reduce your ticket.

FULL PAYMENT IS DUE AT THE TIME THE AMENDMENT OR REDUCED FINE IS REQUESTED.
IF YOU CANNOT PAY OR DO NOT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS LISTED, YOU MUST APPEAR ON YOUR COURT DATE OR ATTEND THE PROSECUTOR’S MONDAY WALK-IN DOCKET. (See Leawood.org for hours).

¹ An amendment involves reducing a moving violation to a non-moving violation upon payment of a higher fine.

² A reduced fine can be imposed upon a plea of guilty to certain tag violations upon proof the offending vehicle is now registered.
